Membership requirements for Post 2 include:

- ◆ *Between the ages of 14 - 20
(age 14 must have completed 8th grade)*
- ◆ *Have good moral character,*
- ◆ *Not convicted or charged with a serious misdemeanor or any felony charges, and*
- ◆ *Drug Free.*

Members of Explorer Post 2 participate in bi-monthly meetings. These meetings provide explorers with an opportunity to learn about the various aspects of the Jefferson City Police Department and other local law enforcement agencies.

Explorers also participate in various community service events such as the JCPD D.A.R.E. Camp, Optimist's Safety on Wheels, Summer Fire School, Kids' Fest, and other community service events.
